

NEWS UPDATE - New Tours 2020

A Northern Cities Odyssey and the Hop Fields of rural England

Beer Tours UK has long experience in exploring our great northern cities. Now we have brought our knowledge and expertise together to bring you a journey across the Pennines - for the Northern Cities Beer Odyssey. You can join this three or four night tour either in Chester or Liverpool before we travel through by train to Manchester and then onto Leeds.

If joining in Chester you will enjoy a tour of the Roman city's historic pubs such as the Bear & Billet and take in one local brewery.

For our Liverpool tour - with our own city guide for the day - we will explore the heritage pubs such as the imposing Philharmonic and idiosyncratic Peter Kavanagh's while also finding some of the off-the-beaten track sights.





When we reach Manchester we will visit a leading independent brewery before strolling along the bustling streets to discover the hidden beer heritage of a proud city that stood at the heart of the Industrial revolution. Crossing the dramatic Pennine range our final destination is the unofficial capital city of Yorkshire which developed rapidly in the heyday of the 19th century woollen trade. Today Leeds is a modern city bristling with small brewers and splendid cask ale pubs such as the Scarborough and Whitelocks. The tours are also available as single city tours.



Later in the year there's the opportunity to visit a hop grower on the Worcestershire/ Herefordshire border to witness the September harvest. This will be followed by an evening in characterful rural inns to sample the ales of the rural Midlands.
